Responsibilities

- Provide coaching on health-related issues to help participants decrease likelihood of injury, optimize movement, and achieve personal wellness goals. Coaching may include soft tissue management for physical issues, nutrition recommendations, fitness and early intervention options.
- Present education to individuals and groups regarding injury prevention, biomechanics and health or wellness topics.
- Perform job task evaluations to identify and mitigate for injury risks.
- Provide on-site incident triage services for employees that report a potential injury to management. (Client depending)
